Our school will be participating in the **18th July Bonus Day** on GlobalGiving. This is a crucial campaign, because it helps us gather much needed funds in mid-year.

As you have all very kindly expressed interest, I would like to give you the following details:-

When? 18th July 2019

What time? Starting at 9.00am ET time and ending 11.59 ET time (ET = Eastern Time)

Which Project? Please go to this micro-project link below, which is part of our main project. Your support will help not only very vulnerable children during the daytime, but also all our children, including our blind children and children who are orphaned or who have been abandoned. All funds raised will go towards providing our children with food, clothing, medical care, transport, Braille materials, state school scholastic materials and training in the Traditional Cambodian Arts. All donations go straight to our projects.

How does the Bonus System Work?

GlobalGiving has \$130,000 in matching funds to give participating NGOs. This is how the matching funds system works:-

- Donations from \$100 - \$499 will be matched at 15%
- Donations from \$500 - \$749 will be matched at 30%
- Donations from \$750 - \$1,000 will be matched at 50%
- Donations above \$1,000 will be matched on the first \$1,000 at 50%

Additionally the NGO who raises the most funds wins an additional prize of \$5,000!

Payments can be made by credit card, debit card, PayPal and Apple Pay. However due to the brevity of the campaign, checks and transfers or CAF payments are **not** eligible.

Remember that all donations must be made at the correct time and early enough not to miss matching funds, but not too early before the official starting time! If you need help working out what is the correct time in your part of the world, please write to me by e-mail in good time!
